

CONSTRUCTION BEGINS ON SPRING HILL HIGH

SPRING HILL — American Constructors, Inc., the construction manager for the new Spring Hill High School, has begun the school's early site work, valued at \$2 million.

The work consists of site grading for the building, parking lots and athletic fields. Crews will also begin installation of major utility services and installation of parking lot bases before final paving.

The remaining work for the project, which includes constructing

the school itself, is valued at \$30 million, and has not yet been awarded. As construction manager, ACI will manage the bid process for the remaining work and provide recommendations to Williamson County Schools.

The new high school will be built on 65 acres of land south of Twin Lakes Drive and east of Buckner Lane. The 265,000-square-foot school will include two two-story classroom wings, two gymnasiums,

an auditorium, a media center and dining/kitchen facilities.

In addition, the school will have athletics features including a football field, soccer field, softball and baseball fields, tennis courts, a track and a practice field. The completion date for the school is June 1, 2011.
